HOW DOES IT WORK?

Prolotherapy uses a sugar and fish oil based solution that is injected into the ligament or tendon where it attaches to the bone. This causes a controlled "good" inflammation in these weak areas, which then increases the blood supply and flow of nutrients and stimulates the tissue to repair itself, strengthening, tightening, and thereby stabilizing the area.

HOW MANY TREATMENTS?

While responses to treatment vary, most people will require 10-12 injections. Each set of treatments is spaced approximately two weeks apart. There is no limit to the number of treatments you can have.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Each patient's medical requirement is unique. Therefore a consultation with the physician is needed to decide the best treatment option (and total cost) for you. Prolotherapy is not covered by insurance.

HOW SOON CAN I GO BACK TO REGULAR PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES?

Prolotherapy helps regenerate tendons and ligaments but it is not a quick fix. The therapy stimulates growth of tendons and ligaments requiring time and rehabilitation. Through regular visits, your doctor will determine when you are able to resume regular physical activities.

If you have a tendon or ligament injury and traditional methods have not provided relief, then Prolotherapy may be a solution. The procedure is less aggressive and less expensive than surgery. It will heal tissues with minimal or no scarring and alleviates further degeneration of the tissues.
